Dr. Krešimir Peračković is a senior research associate at the Ivo Pilar Institute of Social Sciences in Zagreb, where he has worked since 1998. His field of research is postindustrial and information society, social changes and sociology of consumption. He is also an associate professor since 2002 at the Center for Croatian studies-Department of sociology of the University of Zagreb where he teaches two courses at the undergraduate (*Postindustrial Society, Sociology of Consumption* and in the recent past *Sistematic Sociology* and *Introduction to Marketing Research*) and graduate level (*Sociology of Social Change*). His first work experience (1995-1998) was at Croatia Airlines Company as a researcher in the Marketing Research Department. Since 2006 to 2009 he was also an associate professor at the Faculty of Philosophy (Department of Sociology) of the University of Split. His researches at the Institute are directly connected with lectures at universities and with students work (he was a mentor to 27 final or graduate theses). He received *Mijo Mirkovic award* (Faculty of Economics and Business, University of Zagreb – 2011) for his scientific paper published in the Journal for Social Issues (*Društvena istraživanja*).

He completed his undergraduate degree in 1995 at the Faculty of Philosophy (Department of Sociology) of the University of Zagreb where he also received his MSc degree (postgraduate program *Sociology of Migration*) in 2001, and successfully completed his dissertation in 2006 (*Service Society – Changes in Socio-profesional Structure of Croatian Society from 1971 to 2001*).
